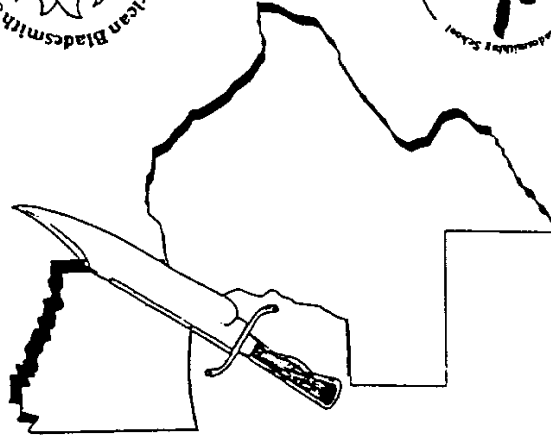

The Cutting Competition will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 29, 2006. When checking in on Saturday, October 28, 2006, all cutting competition participants must sign-in and declare their intention to compete. This allows the judges to know the exact number of raw materials and test items to be purchased on Sunday morning. You may register for the following division:

Blades - ABS test divisions 10" blade - 15" overall 2" wide, all participants must have sheath or case for knife.

Cutting Contest: This is any cutting blade that meets the above criteria. The pieces will be inspected for construction method by the judges. If any of the judges feel the piece to be unsafe to use then you will not be allowed to enter the contest. For safety reasons, a leather or nylon tether/lanyard in the handle will be required for each participant. First and second place trophies will be awarded in the Open Division by B. R. Hughes, ABS Co-Founder and member of the ABS Board of Directors. All demonstrations and classes will be held at the Bill Moran School of Bladesmithing. **(THE NYLON OR LEATHER TETHER/LANYARD IS A REQUIREMENT.)**
